### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill 1) prohibits a court from according deference to agency interpretations of law and prohibits agencies from seeking deference in any proceedings to agency interpretations of law; 2) establishes various requirements with adoption and use of guidance documents by agencies; and 3) provides that settlement agreements do not confer rule-making authority.

The Department of Workforce Development estimates that, if enacted, it could provide for the workload associated with the activities required under the bill on an ongoing basis with existing resources.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implications of the proposed bill are indeterminate at this time.
