Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes various changes to the regulation of aquaculture and fish farms.

A. One-Time Costs

The bill is expected to result in an increased one-time workload related to updating program procedures and databases, developing General Permits, revising application materials, legal review of documents, training staff, and conducting customer outreach. Implementation is estimated to require a one-time expenditure of \$46,300 and 0.6 FTE.

B. Revenue Impacts

Exemptions

- a. The exemption for artificial waterbody creation (ponds) will result in an estimated decrease in general permit (GP) fees of \$2,400/year and an estimated decrease in individual permit fees for \$1000/year.
- b. The exemption for normal aquaculture activities will result in an estimated decrease in individual permit (IP) fees of \$6,700/year and an estimated decrease in general permit (GP) fees of \$2,800/year.
