2017 Wisconsin Act 61
[2017 Assembly Bill 528]

Group Deer Hunting

2017 Wisconsin Act 61 eliminated the requirement that a person validate a carcass tag and affix the carcass tag to a deer after it is harvested. 2017 Wisconsin Act 61 restores a provision eliminated by Act 61 that prohibits the use of a youth antlerless deer approval by another member of a group gun deer hunting party. The Act also clarifies that group gun deer hunting is subject to the same restrictions that were in place prior to the enactment of Act 61, except those requirements relating directly to deer carcass tags.
