2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 528

2017 Wisconsin Act 59 eliminated all requirements relating to deer carcass tags. A provision prohibiting the use of a youth antlerless deer approval by another member of a group gun deer hunting party was also eliminated along with the elimination of these carcass tag requirements. 2017 Assembly Bill 528 restores this prohibition.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 both restores the prohibition described above and clarifies that group gun deer hunting is subject to the same restrictions that were in place prior to the enactment of Act 59, except those requirements relating directly to deer carcass tags.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Bernier. On October 31, 2017, the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage recommended adoption of the substitute amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, by unanimous votes.
