2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 635

2017 Assembly Bill 635 makes various changes to Wisconsin's Motor Vehicle Franchise Law with regard to dealer reimbursement for covered work performed on behalf of a manufacturer, importer, or distributor.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Among other provisions, **the bill** prohibits a manufacturer, importer, or distributor from charging back amounts paid for covered work based on a dealer's failure to properly process a warranty claim if the dealer provides reasonable proof that the work for which the claim is made was actually performed and was subject to reasonable compensation. **Assembly Amendment 1** deletes this requirement.

BILL HISTORY

On February 22, 2018, Representative Ballweg offered Assembly Amendment 1, and the Assembly adopted the amendment and passed the bill, as amended, on voice votes.
