2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 641

Generally, 2017 Assembly Bill 641 codifies certain practices of the Department of Safety and Professional Services, relating to delegation of plumbing and commercial building plan review and inspection to local units of government. The bill also creates an electronic renewal process for these delegations.

Under current law, certain local units of government may review alterations of buildings containing less than 100,000 cubic feet of volume. Assembly Amendment 1 to the bill revises this authority to apply to *spaces involving* less than 100,000 cubic feet of volume.

BILL HISTORY

2017 Assembly Bill 641 was introduced by Representatives Hutton and Brooks on November 14, 2017. Representative Hutton offered Assembly Amendment 1 on January 4, 2018. On January 11, 2018, the Assembly Committee on Housing and Real Estate recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 and passage of Assembly Bill 641 on successive votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
