2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 903

2017 Assembly Bill 903 (“the bill”) makes various changes related to the regulation of occupations and buildings and safety, as administered by the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) and the professional credentialing boards it houses.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2

Assembly Amendment 2 generally prohibits local governments from regulating tattooing and body piercing, unless authority is delegated by DSPS. It also changes the credential renewal date for physicians with a degree of doctor of osteopathy from March 1 of each even-numbered year to November 1 of each odd-numbered year.

BILL HISTORY

On February 13, 2018, Representative Ballweg offered Assembly Amendment 2. On February 15, 2018, the Assembly Committee on Regulatory Licensing Reform recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 2, and adoption of Assembly Amendment 2 on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0. The committee then recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0. On February 21, 2018, the Assembly adopted Assembly Amendment 2 and passed the bill, as amended, on voice votes.
