2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 453

July 26, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives CROWLEY, YOUNG, BOWEN, FIELDS, ANDERSON, VRUWINK, MASON, ZAMARRIPA, BROSTOFF, POPE, BERCEAU and SPREITZER, cosponsored by Senators L. TAYLOR, JOHNSON, LARSON, RISSER and CARPENTER. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.455 (2) (e) and 165.985 of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 community relations grants to counties and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Justice to award grants of up to \$600,000 in the 2017-19 fiscal biennium to counties in which at least 10 percent of the population is composed of minorities, which are defined as persons who are Black, Hispanic, American Indian, Eskimo, Aleut, native Hawaiian, Asian-Indian, or of Asian-Pacific origin. The grants are to improve relations between law enforcement and the community.
