2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 632

1 AN ACT *to amend* 20.435 (7) (bc) of the statutes; **relating to:** grants for
2 Alzheimer's disease and dementia awareness and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to award grants to increase awareness of Alzheimer's disease and dementia in rural and underserved urban areas.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16 department of health services shall award grants in a total amount not to exceed
17 \$500,000 for the purpose of increasing awareness of Alzheimer's disease and
18 dementia in rural and underserved urban areas.

19 **SECTION 4. Fiscal changes.**

20 (1) ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the
21 statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under section
22 20.435 (7) (bc) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is increased
23 by \$500,000 to award grants under SECTION 3 (1) of this act.

24 **SECTION 5. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,
