*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill authorizes and funds, for the 2017-19 fiscal biennium, four new criminal investigation agent positions at the Department of Justice to focus on drug interdiction and drug trafficking.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4             (1) CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION AGENTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of  
5             the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455  
6             (2) (a) of the statutes the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is increased by  
7             \$420,000 to increase the authorized FTE positions for the department by 4.0 GPR  
8             criminal investigation agents focused on drug interdiction and drug trafficking. In

1 the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the  
2 department of justice under section 20.455 (2) (a) of the statutes the dollar amount  
3 for fiscal year 2018-19 is increased by \$420,000 to provide funding for the positions  
4 authorized under this subsection.
