### Christopher:

Sections 3 and 4 of the bill relate to school safety plans. Under current law, "[e]ach school board and the governing body of each private school shall have in effect a school safety plan." Given this language, it appears that Melissa is correct: currently, independent charter schools are not required to have school safety plans, so the requirements the bill adds to school safety plans regarding barricade devices do not apply to independent charter schools. Which of the following approaches do you want to use to fix this issue?

- 1. Make all school safety plan requirements apply to independent charter schools. (Then, by extension, the barricade device requirements would also apply to independent charter schools.)
- Create a separate provision that requires independent charter schools to develop guidelines and to provide training regarding barricade devices. (Under this alternative, independent charter schools will continue to be excluded from the other school safety plan requirements.)
