Marc and Mark,

Rep. Ohnstad asked that I request 3 simple amendments to AB 234 to be ready for our exec session in Jobs and the Economy on Tuesday.

- 1. Rather than requiring the state/political subdivisions to amend contracts after 25 months in the provision beginning at page 12, line 23; we would instead like to grandfather existing contracts and make contacts subject to the bill's provisions upon their conclusion/modification.
- 2. Add "public health and safety" to the ROW study committee's charge in the provision at page 28, line 9-11.
- 3. A similar amendment to AA19 to ASA1 to 2017 AB 348 as amended by the new bill to provide for a more robust local oversight of the placement of the 5G technology (don't modify setbacks provision).


