The language in 275 states that the subsection also applies to bid contracts under 84.07 which would encompass emergency contracts that you use express bidding on.

Add to the end of the proposed language:

This subsection does not apply to any contracts under 84.07(1b).

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 285

June 13, 2019 - Offered by Representative SANFELIPPO.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “improvements” insert “and value of work estimates”.
- 3 **2.** Page 2, line 3: after “competent” insert “and responsible”.
- 4 **3.** Page 2, line 19: delete “the paragraph” and substitute “this paragraph”.
- 5 **4.** Page 2, line 20: after “competent” insert “and responsible”.
- 6 **5.** Page 3, line 1: delete lines 1 and 2 and substitute “affect public safety or
- 7 project cost or project schedule, the department may file with the joint committee on
- 8 finance a request to authorize awarding the contract to the sole bidder. If the
- 9 cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance do not notify the department within
- 10 14 working days after the date on which the department submits the request that
- 11 the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the request, the
- 12 department may award the contract. If, within 14 working days after the date on

1 which the department submits the request, the cochairpersons of the joint committee
 2 on finance notify the department that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the
 3 purpose of reviewing the request, the department may award the contract only as
 4 approved, or modified and approved, by the committee. The department shall submit
 5 to the joint committee on finance quarterly reports listing any bids rejected or
 6 contracts awarded under this paragraph.”

7 **6.** Page 3, line 7: after that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 2c.** 84.06 (2) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

9 84.06 (2) (d) The department shall review, update, and document its estimates
 10 of the reasonable value of the work for an improvement within 2 weeks before the
 11 date on which bids for that improvement must be submitted to the department.

12 **SECTION 2e.** 84.06 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

13 84.06 (2) (e) In determining whether a bid exceeds the estimated reasonable
 14 value of the work, the department shall consider any addendums affecting the value
 15 of the work for an improvement that were issued before the date on which bids for
 16 that improvement must be submitted to the department.”
