## 2019 SENATE BILL 83

1 AN ACT *to amend* 125.51 (3) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** retail sales of 2 intoxicating liquor for consumption off the licensed premises.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 125.51 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read: 3 4 125.51 (3) (b) In all municipalities electing by ordinance to come under this 5 paragraph, a retail "Class B" license authorizes the sale of intoxicating liquor to be 6 consumed by the glass only on the premises where sold and also authorizes the sale 7 of intoxicating liquor in the original package or container, in multiples not to exceed 8 4 liters at any one time, and any quantity, to be consumed off the premises where sold. 9 Wine, however, may be sold for consumption off the premises in the original package 10 or otherwise in any quantity. This paragraph does not apply to a winery that has
