Hi Eric,

I'm sorry to do this again, but I wanted to send a couple of minor changes to this draft:

- I'd like to make the name in the analysis and statutory provisions (so, from the analysis paragraph through p. 2, line 7) to be consistent – "Staff Sergeant Daniel D. Busch" or "Staff Sergeant Daniel D. Busch Memorial Highway" in all references. The references to "Dan", "Daniel", etc. in the nonstatutory provisions are fine the way they are.
- In the nonstatutory provisions, change "Ram-Busch" to "Rambusch" since that seems to be the correct spelling based on all resources I can find online
- Could you also put this (with these changes) into a /1 draft? (Is that possible?)

I also wanted to let you know that Sen. Erpenbach's office will be introducing a companion bill, so if you could make this draft accessible to them as well we would appreciate it. I'm copying Tryg Knutson from their office in case you have any questions on that.
