



## 2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 137

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 450.01 (16) (k) and 450.035 (2); and *to create* 450.035 (2c),  
2             450.035 (2i) and 450.035 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** pharmacists and  
3             pharmacy students administering vaccines.

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 450.01 (16) (k) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5             450.01 (**16**) (k) Administering prescribed drug products and devices under s.  
6             450.035 (1r) and, pursuant to vaccination protocols, vaccines.  
7             **SECTION 2.** 450.035 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:  
8             450.035 (**2**) A pharmacist may not administer a vaccine unless he or she has  
9             successfully completed 12 hours in a course of study and training, approved by the  
10            Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education or the board, in vaccination storage,

1 protocols, administration technique, emergency procedures, and record keeping and  
2 has satisfied the requirements specified in sub. (2t). ~~A~~ Except as provided under  
3 sub. (2c), a pharmacist may not administer a vaccine under this subsection to a  
4 person who is under the age of 6.

5 **SECTION 3.** 450.035 (2c) of the statutes is created to read:

6 450.035 (2c) A pharmacist may administer a vaccine under sub. (2) to a person  
7 who is under the age of 6 if all of the following apply:

8 (a) The vaccine is administered pursuant to a prescription order issued within  
9 the 29 days immediately preceding the day on which the vaccine is administered.

10 (b) The pharmacist has successfully completed a course of instruction approved  
11 by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education or the board that includes the  
12 administration of vaccines to children under the age of 6.

13 **SECTION 4.** 450.035 (2i) of the statutes is created to read:

14 450.035 (2i) (a) Subject to subs. (2) and (2g), a pharmacist or a person engaged  
15 in the practice of pharmacy under s. 450.03 (1) (f) or (g) may administer without a  
16 prescription order any vaccine listed in the current immunization schedules  
17 recommended by the federal advisory committee on immunization practices and  
18 published by the federal centers for disease control and prevention.

19 (b) Subject to subs. (2) and (2g), a pharmacist or a person engaged in the  
20 practice of pharmacy under s. 450.03 (1) (f) or (g) may initiate and administer any  
21 vaccine not listed in the current immunization schedules recommended by the  
22 federal advisory committee on immunization practices and published by the federal  
23 centers for disease control and prevention if the vaccine is administered pursuant to  
24 a prescription order, vaccination protocol, or standing order.

25 **SECTION 5.** 450.035 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

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1           450.035 (4) A pharmacist or person engaged in the practice of pharmacy under  
2           s. 450.03 (1) (f) or (g) who administers a vaccine to a person under this section shall  
3           update, or cause a pharmacy to update, the Wisconsin Immunization Registry  
4           established by the department of health services within 7 days of administering the  
5           vaccine.
