2019 WISCONSIN ACT 29

AN ACT *to amend* 893.82 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** service of notice of claim against state officer, employee, or agent.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 893.82 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

893.82 (5) The notice under sub. (3) shall be sworn

to by the claimant and shall be served upon the attorney general at his or her office in the capitol or at the department of justice by personal service or by certified mail. Notice If served by certified mail, notice shall be considered to be given upon mailing for the purpose of computing the time of giving notice.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
