2019 SENATE BILL 349

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 168.105 of the statutes; **relating to:** requirements for devices
2 that dispense gasoline-ethanol fuel blends.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 168.105 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **168.105 Dispensing gasoline-ethanol fuel blends.** A dispensing device at
5 a retail station may be used to dispense through the same fueling nozzle and hose
6 gasoline-ethanol fuel blends containing greater than 10 percent and not more than
7 15 percent ethanol by volume, gasoline containing no ethanol, and gasoline-ethanol
8 fuel blends containing not more than 10 percent ethanol by volume if any of the
9 following applies:

10 **(1)** All of the following apply:

1 (a) The retail station provides a device having at least one fueling nozzle and
2 hose that dispenses only gasoline-ethanol fuel blends containing no more than 10
3 percent ethanol by volume.

4 (b) A label satisfying the requirements under s. 168.11 (1) (b) 3. is prominently
5 affixed to the dispensing device stating, "Passenger Vehicles Only. Use in Other
6 Vehicles, Engines and Equipment May Violate Federal Law."

7 (c) The retail station displays signs informing customers of the availability and
8 location of the device required under par. (a).

9 **(2)** A label satisfying the requirements under s. 168.11 (1) (b) 3. is prominently
10 affixed to the dispensing device that states that a minimum purchase of 4 gallons is
11 required.
