## 2017 SENATE BILL 815

February 16, 2018 - Introduced by JOINT COMMITTEE ON EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS.  
Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 AN ACT relating to: ratification of the agreement negotiated between the  
2 University of Wisconsin-Madison and the Wisconsin State Building Trades  
3 Negotiating Committee, for the 2016-17<sup>9 20</sup> fiscal year, covering employees in the  
4 building trades crafts collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an  
5 expenditure of funds.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit negotiated for the 2016-17<sup>19 20</sup> fiscal year under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
