DEADLINE: **Monday, Feb. 4, 2019 at 5 p.m.**

We will be introducing LRB-1258/1 to require the state Department of Public Instruction to include the percentage of students participating in music, dance, drama and visual arts on the annual school and school district accountability report cards.

Numerous studies have shown that schools offering more extensive opportunities in the arts have experienced better pupil attendance and achievements in other subjects.

According to a 2017 doctoral dissertation by Gresham Community Schools Principal Benjamin Heninger, the study of instrumental music at a rural La Crosse high school was statistically significant and positively related to the students' ACT Aspire test scores in English, science, reading and math. Of all the independent variables tested in this study – gender, race, special education and poverty – none of them made as large of a statistically significant positive contribution as instrumental music courses.

LRB-1258/1 should not create that much – if any – additional work for school districts since many of them say their Student Information Systems already collect this data. Furthermore, these statistics are already being sent to DPI under the "Roster" heading. Officials would only need to upload the information into the state-wide WISEdata collection system.

The arts data would be included on the report cards for informational purposes only and not be considered in a district's accountability calculations. But further transparency on student engagement measures is expected to help encourage local communities to better understand and support what their schools are offering.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Public Instruction to include in the annual school district and school accountability report, commonly referred to as school and school district report cards, the percentage of pupils participating in music, dance, drama, and visual arts. Under the bill, DPI must include this information for each high school and school district and must also include the statewide percentage of pupils participating in each subject. The bill specifies that this information may not be used to evaluate a school's performance or school district's improvement.
