(1) MOTORBOATS OTHER THAN PERSONAL WATERCRAFT.

30.678(1)(a)

(a) No person under 10 years of age may operate a motorboat.

30.678(1)(b)

(b) No person who is at least 10 years of age but under 12 years of age may operate a motorboat unless he or she is accompanied in the motorboat by a parent or guardian or by a person who is at least 18 years of age and who is designated by a parent or guardian. However, the parent or guardian must have completed a Boating Safety Course that is accepted by the WI DNR, or born before January 1, 1989.

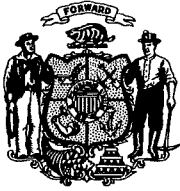
