Chris, which sunset(s) are you referring to? There is a provision that sunsets 4/1/20 that requires a PDMP look up before a prescriber issues a prescription for a patient. There is also a requirement for the Controlled Substances Board to do quarterly reviews of the PDMP, and that requirement sunsets 10/30/20. (There is no general sunset for the PDMP).
