Hi Bethany,

Tom and I spoke with Tyler (copied) and his client as to their concerns about ensuring the simple amendment maintains consistency with current federal law. We were able to find a solution addressing all of our concerns by recommending additional language to be included in the simple amendment draft. This addition will clarify the separate consent required by the amendment is consistent with existing law, as well as any future changes to state or federal law relating to privacy.

The agreed upon language would be added to simple amendment at the end of line 4 ", in a manner consistent with applicable law."

Therefore the sentence would read , "independent from any other consent, permission, disclosure, or acknowledgement, in a manner consistent with applicable law."
