SECTION 2. 103.79(1) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 103.79(2) of the statutes is renumbered 103.79 and amended to read:

103.79 The Department may investigate and fix by general or special order reasonable regulations relative to the provision of caddy services by minors to individuals, golf courses, and others. The regulations may include a waiver or modification of permit requirements for caddies. The investigations and orders shall be made as provided under s.103.005.

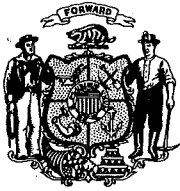
