***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law requires the Department of Transportation to conduct a motor vehicle emissions inspection and maintenance program in counties in which the air quality does not meet certain federal standards. Under the program, most motor vehicles that are subject to emissions limitations established by the Department of Natural Resources must pass periodic emissions inspections and may not be registered by DOT unless they have passed these inspections. Certain motor vehicles are exempt from emissions inspections, including mopeds, motorcycles, and off-road utility vehicles. This bill exempts autocycles from emissions inspections.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 **SECTION 1.** 285.30 (5) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 285.30 (5) (c) A motor vehicle exempt from registration under s. 341.05, except  
5 that a motor vehicle owned by the United States is not exempt unless it comes under  
6 par. (a), (b), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (j), ~~or~~ (k), or (m).

**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE BILL 768**

February 12, 2020 - Offered by Senator LEMAHIEU.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: delete “inspections.” and substitute “inspections and  
3 providing registration plates to autocycles previously registered as motorcycles.”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 2: after that line insert:

5 **“SECTION 3m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) (a) In this subsection, “autocycle” means a motor vehicle that has 3 wheels  
7 in contact with the ground, is designed with seating that does not require operators  
8 or any occupants to straddle or sit astride it, has a steering wheel, and is originally  
9 manufactured to meet federal motor vehicle safety standards for motorcycles under  
10 49 CFR part 571.

11 (b) The department of transportation shall issue an autocycle registration plate  
12 to any individual who applies for a motorcycle registration for an autocycle prior to  
13 April 30, 2020, and who requests an autocycle plate.

(c) The department of transportation shall notify an individual receiving an autocycle plate under par. (b) that the individual is required to destroy the motorcycle plate previously issued for the autocycle.

(d) The department of transportation may not charge a fee for the issuance of an autocycle plate under par. (b) other than a fee for counter services.

(e) This subsection does not apply after April 30, 2021<sup>?</sup>.
