## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed bill requires the WTCS and UWS enter into an agreement that establishes policies, beginning in 2020-21, that credits for courses in different subject areas are transferable and may include core general education courses. The agreement may not be less than 75 credits or nine credits for each subject area, which ever is greater.

It is estimated that this bill would have a state and local fiscal impact on the WTCS System Office and the WTCS district colleges. However, implementation of this law would not require additional resources. Under current law, the system board and districts are required to continuously maintain and update the current agreement with the UWS. The requirement in the proposed bill would be absorbed within the work currently being completed as required by law.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
