#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill establishes a sum sufficient appropriation for the Groundwater Coordinating Council (GCC) to perform its functions. It is assumed that the funding source for the appropriation would be the environmental management account of the environmental fund.

State Fiscal Effect--Costs

A. The Department estimates additional costs of \$237,800 for the GCC to perform its functions under s. 160.50, Wis. Stats, as detailed in the bill. The estimate is based on original funding levels for groundwater management [\$200,000/yr. appropriated in s. 20.370 (2)(ar) in FY 1996] being restored and inflated to 2020 dollars.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics consumer price index, today's prices in 2020 are 64.87% higher than average prices since 1996. Therefore, based on these assumptions:

 $[(\$200,000/yr. in FY 1996 \times 1.6487 inflation adjustment) - \$91,900 current funding level in s. 20.370 (4)(ar)] = \$237,800$ 

- B. The Department also estimates that 1.0 FTE and \$102,500 would be needed to coordinate GCC activities (\$100,000 in salary and fringe plus \$2,500 for supplies).
- C. The bill would require the Department to write and implement rules for groundwater quality standards recommendations received from DHS. The fiscal estimate of this component to the bill is indeterminate.
