Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a continuing GPR appropriation \$300,000 annually to be used by the Department of Administration (DOA) to award equal grants to each Continuum of Care organization in Wisconsin, as designated by the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development, to hire housing navigators. These funds may not supplant existing funds for homelessness prevention and other services for the homeless.

The housing navigators would not be hired directly by the Department's Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR), but rather by the aforementioned Continuum of Care organizations with DEHCR supervising the usage of the funds to ensure compliance with the purposes of the program.

The housing navigators program would be overseen and monitored by DEHCR. The duties to the department under this program would be to "ensure that grant funds are expended to fill housing navigator positions that are reasonably balanced among the geographic areas served by each continuum of care organization."

The Department would primarily incur one-time costs associated with this bill related to updating internet and printed materials, monitoring forms and contract documents, and meeting with stakeholder groups to ensure successful implementation of the bill. The Department anticipates it will be able to absorb the workload with current staffing levels and expenditure authority.
