Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a student enrolled in a University of Wisconsin System school or technical college who served in the military to object to the transfer of academic credit from the student's military transcript to the UW System school or technical college.

Under current law, UW System schools and technical colleges must accept all credits. This can have a negative impact on some students as their total credits exceed thresholds for financial aid.

The fiscal impact is indeterminate but there would likely be increased costs related to additional correspondence and coordination with students as well as processing implications. The proposed bill could potentially reduce costs related to financial aid appeals.
