Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill would require the department to devote staff resources to educating business operators, creating procedures for evaluating waiver requests, conducting the waiver request evaluations and enforcing violations of the bill's provisions. The staff resources needed would be shifted from existing functions. The majority of businesses affected by the bill are directly regulated by local health departments acting as the department's agents. Personnel in these programs would devote an unknown amount of time answering questions, educating business operators about how to request a variance, and informing the department of violations (or prosecuting violations if it is deemed the agent programs have authority to do so).

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The number of waiver requests and violations cannot be predicted at this time. It is likely that costs would decrease over time, as the bill's provisions become better known and business operators adopt alternative packaging materials.
