### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Public Instruction must approve certain driver education courses offered by school districts and establish minimum standards for driver education courses offered by private driver schools. Under this bill, all approved driver education courses must acquaint each student with the hazards posed by highway work zones and provide at least 30 minutes of instruction in safely dealing with these hazards.

In 2018-19, the Department approved 139 programs (98 Public Schools, 2 Private schools and 39 through CESAs). The additional program costs to provide this required instruction is expected to be minimal. The Department is not expected to incur additional cost under this legislation and would inform districts through a bi-weekly mailing and include it in future PII 1709 Driver Education Program Approval forms.
