Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires a one-time expenditure of no more than \$1,500,000.00 from the Harbor Assistance Program (HAP) [either SEG [20.395(2)(cq)] or Bonding [20.866(2)(uv)]] to reimburse the city of Green Bay for harbor improvements related to port expansion and the relocation of coal piles. The department assumes that costs for relocating coal piles would not be an eligible expense for use of bond proceeds and that these costs would be paid using SEG funds. Funding this grant will reduce the state funds that would otherwise go to eligible projects in SFY-20/21 by 20.33%.
