### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law prohibits technical colleges from discriminating against person's on the basis of sex, age, race, color, religion or national origin.

Under the proposed legislation, technical colleges would be prohibited from discriminating against persons on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.

Current law also prohibits technical colleges from discriminating against students on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, sex, national origin, disability, ancestry, age, sexual orientation, pregnancy, material status or parental status.

The proposed legislation prohibits a technical college from discriminating against student's on the basis of gender identity, gender expression and the status of the student's parent.

There would be no fiscal impact if the proposed legislation is enacted.
