Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires HEAB to establish a program to award grants to persons in this state for research into spinal cord injuries. The grants must support research into new and innovative treatments and rehabilitative efforts for the functional improvement of individuals with spinal cord injuries. HEAB must make an annual report to the legislature every January about the grant. HEAB will be required to hold symposia every two years for grant recipients to present their research findings.

HEAB is also required to appoint a spinal cord injury council with one member representing the University of WI School of Medicine and Public Health, , one member representing the Medical College of WI, and the following members: 1) a person with a spinal cord injury; 2) a family member of a person with a spinal cord injury; 4) a physician specializing in the treatment of spinal cord injuries; 5) a neurosurgery researcher; and 6) a researcher employed by the veterans health administration of the federal Dept of Veteran's Affairs. Members of the council will have two year terms. The council will develop criteria for HEAB to evaluate and award grants, review and make recommendations on grant applications, and perform other duties specified by HEAB.
