Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The substitute amendment to SB 423 establishes lead testing and remediation requirements for drinking water sources in schools, with the governing bodies responsible for compliance and paying for the costs. SB 423 includes child care programs established by school boards under 120.13 (14) to the definition of schools and specifies that the governing body is the school board that established the child care program. In addition, the Department of Health Services (DHS) is required to create a document providing technical guidance on a model plan for testing and remediating lead contamination in potable water sources. The Department of Children and Families (DCF) is required to post this guidance document on its Internet site.

There is minimal fiscal effect on the Department. Any costs related to monitoring and posting the guidance document can be absorbed with existing resources.
