Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill has many components, only one of which affects DPI. Some of the topics addressed by this bill include housing stability, workforce development, mental health, and transportation.

This bill requires the Department of Public Instruction to annually issue a report to the legislature on the number of homeless children and youths in Wisconsin public schools. Under the bill, "homeless children and youths" is defined by reference to federal law providing homeless assistance.

State: No effect

DPI already collects the number of homeless children and youths in public schools and reports it, just not to the legislature. Including the legislature in the list of report recipients can be absorbed in the daily duties of DPI staff.

Local: No effect

Because they already collect and report such data, school districts will not be impacted by DPI's requirement to report to the legislature the number of homeless children and youths in public schools.
