Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits a pet store from selling dogs or cats. Currently, persons who sell or offer to sell at least 25 dogs per year must be licensed by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), pursuant to Wis. Stat. s. 173.41 and Wis. Admin. Code Ch. ATCP 16.

This bill would decrease revenue due to a decrease in the number of licensed dog sellers. DATCP would no longer license dog dealers who operate as pet stores. Of the 275 licensed dog sellers, it is unknown how many are dog dealers operating as pet stores. Dog breeders would no longer be able to sell dogs to pet stores and the number of licensed dog breeders may likely decrease also. It is unknown how many licensees will no longer need a license so the amount of decrease in revenue is not able to be determined.

This bill would have a minimal impact on the cost of administering the program due to a reduction in the number of licensed entities no longer needing to be inspected.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This bill would decrease revenue. This bill would have a minimal impact on costs to administer the program.
