Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill allows graduate health science classes at the UWS to commence before September 1; exempts UWS from or repeals requirements for numerous reports; makes changes to sexual assault and harassment reporting; and requires DOA rather than UWS to submit biennial plans to JCF and the legislature on energy cost reduction for the UWS.
