Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-496 requires that if an institution of higher education under s.39.53(1), a school board, operator of a charter school under s. 118.40(2r) or (2x) or governing body of a private school issues student identification cards, the cards must include contact information for suicide prevention hotlines. The bill lists several allowable options for suicide/crisis prevention hotlines, including text-based or telephone-based options.

The information may be included on the identification card either by printing the information on the card or by affixing to the card a sticker that contains the information.

The costs associated with implementation of these provisions are negligible and can be absorbed by the colleges.
