Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the Department of Safety and Professional Services or a local government from preventing an elementary or secondary school from installing a barricade device on an interior door in a school building. If a school installs a barricade device, the bill requires the school safety plan to include guidelines and training related to the use of the barricade device.

It is unknown how many schools will choose to install barricade devices but the additional cost of amending the school safety plan and providing training on the use of the device can be considered by the school district at the time the decision is made.
