Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a new office (the "Legislative Office of the Inspector General") comprised of "14 inspectors general and their staff." The bill would require DFI to (1) "provide office space at the agency headquarters for the inspector general assigned to the agency and for his or her staff"; and (2) "pay for all services provided by the inspectors general." Under the bill, DFI would share an inspector general with the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance.

For purposes of this estimate, DFI has estimated half the cost of services to be provided by the inspector general assigned to it, assuming that OCI would be responsible for the other half. That does not apply to overhead costs such as office space; because they are in different locations, DFI and OCI would each need to provide its own office space and supplies for the inspector general. While the legislation references additional "staff," the bill's appropriation provision creates only the 14 inspector general provisions and it is unclear whether (and what number) of additional staff members are contemplated. For that reason, this estimate does not take into account the cost of any additional staff of the inspector general.
