Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill would create a nonpartisan, legislative service agency known as the "Legislative Office of Inspector General," consisting of 14 inspectors general and their staff who are assigned to and housed at certain state agencies, including the Board of Regents of the UW System. The Joint Committee on Legislative Organization would appoint each inspector general for a six-year term expiring March 1 of the odd-numbered year.

Each state agency would provide office space for the inspector general assigned to the agency and must pay for services provided by the inspectors general.

The bill provides specifications about the duties and requirements of the inspector generals.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The fiscal impact is unclear until guidelines are established for the provisions in the bill.
