Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The department manages the "Traffic and Criminal Software" (TraCS) system utilized by law enforcement personnel to issue traffic citations. This bill changes the dollar amounts for forfeiture "negligent operation of vehicle" violations. These changes would need to be made to the TraCS system to maintain parity with statute.

The one-time required changes to the TraCS system software can be folded into existing maintenance tasks at no additional cost.
