Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates the prohibition that a city, village, town, or county may not enact and administer an ordinance requiring an employer to provide an employee with leave for certain family or medical reasons.

If enacted, local governments may choose to explore options for development and implementation of local ordinances. The fiscal effect for local governments is currently indeterminate.
