Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently when an individual applies for a veteran identifier for his or her driver license or identification card, their social security number is automatically checked against a list of qualified individuals maintained by the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA). If that individual's social security number is not on the WDVA list, he or she can still obtain the identifier if they provide documentation from a county veteran service officer (CVSO). This bill would shift some of the responsibility of verifying an applicant's qualifications from state and county veteran organizations to division of motor vehicles (DMV) staff. While the applicant would still have the option to register with WDVA, or obtain documentation from a CVSO, the applicant would also be able to provide their own verification that they meet the new chapter 343 definition of veteran. The division plans to accept active or retired military identification cards and federal form DD214 as proof of veteran status.

The division expects this bill to result in an increase in applications for the identifier, resulting in an increase in transaction times for field stations. Additional training would also be necessary for all field staff. Currently the division sees approximately 1,600 applicants per year who has not registered with WDVA. If there is an increase of 25% in applications for the veteran identifier made by individuals who have not registered first with WDVA there would be an increase in work of less than .05 FTE.

The IT changes needed to implement the changes made in this bill would cost approximately \$14,200.
