Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a town to determine whether to require its municipal judge to execute and file an official bond. If no bond is required, the town must obtain an appropriate insurance policy that covers the judge.

This bill does not appear to involve the state court system in this process, therefore it will have no fiscal impact on the circuit courts. It may have a fiscal impact on the town, if the town has a municipal court. The fiscal impact will depend on whether the insurance policy costs more or less than the official bond.
