2019 Assembly Bill 567

**Assembly
Amendment 1**

2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 567

The Little Plover River Watershed Enhancement Project was initiated in 2017. The Village of Plover received a \$100,000 grant for the project under the 2017 Biennial Budget Act.

2019 Assembly Bill 567 appropriates \$100,000 from the environmental fund in the current fiscal biennium and requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to provide those funds as a second grant to the Village of Plover for continued implementation of wetland restoration and watershed enhancement designed to increase the flow of the Little Plover River.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

During the 2019-21 and 2021-23 fiscal biennia, Assembly Amendment 1 requires DNR and the Village of Plover to monitor the flow of the Little Plover River and to annually report stream flow data for the river to the Joint Committee on Finance and relevant standing committees of the Legislature.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Shankland offered Assembly Amendment 1 on January 15, 2020. On January 16, 2020, the Assembly Committee on Environment voted to recommend adoption of the amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, both on unanimous votes.
