2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 8

The bill creates an exception to the current requirement that an assessor notify a taxpayer when the taxpayer's property is assessed at a different total than the prior year. Under the bill, an assessor is not required to provide notice of a change in assessment if the assessed land is classified as agricultural land for the current and prior year and the difference between the assessments is \$300 or less.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 increases the difference between the assessments to \$500 or less.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Thiesfeldt on February 28, 2019. On March 27, 2019, the Assembly Committee on Local Government voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1, and the bill as amended, by votes of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
