2019 SENATE BILL 246

The bill creates an exception to the current requirement that a voter state his or her name and address prior to receiving an election ballot. Under the bill, a voter is not required to state his or her name and address if the voter is unable to do so **because of a disability**.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

The amendment deletes the reference to a disability in the exception created by the bill. Thus, under the amendment, a voter is not required to state his or her name and address if the voter is unable to do so.

BILL HISTORY

Senate Amendment 1 was offered by Senator Bernier on June 17, 2019. On June 18, 2019, the Senate Committee on Elections, Ethics, and Rural Issues recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
