Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the governor to allocate \$100,000 of the funds accepted under the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 for a grant to the city of Lodi for the construction of a pedestrian bridge across Spring Creek.

- I. Assumptions
- A. Although the bill does not specify, it is assumed that the Department would be tasked with administering the grant.
- B. The eligibility of ARPA funds for the project would need to be validated.
- II. Fiscal Effect

The Department would likely administer the grant in manner similar to Stewardship LUG (local units of government) grants that support nature-based outdoor recreation activities. The cost and workload associated with administering the grant would be minimal and absorbed within the duties of existing staff in the Bureau of Community Financial Assistance.
